Phonics Unit 8

Students will begin Fundations Unit 8 this week. In this unit, students spell and read four-sound, short-vowel words with consonant blends and consonant-digraph blends. Students are also introduced to r-controlled vowels such as those in star, horn, bird, and turn. Example unit words include stop, pest, flag, frog, lunch, and bench. In addition to the trick words taught previously, students must also read, write and spell these trick words:


