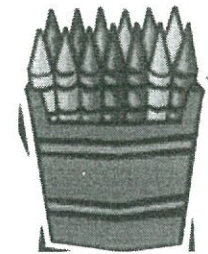

Phonics Unit 3

We have begun Unit 3 in Phonics. In this unit, students learn that digraphs **wh, ch, sh, th,** and **ck** "stick together" to form one sound, even though there are two letters. Students spell 3-sound, short vowel words such as wish, chop, sock, thin, and whip and the trick words below.

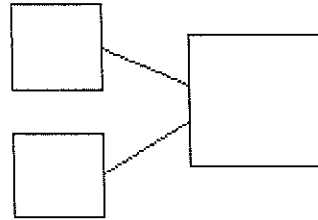
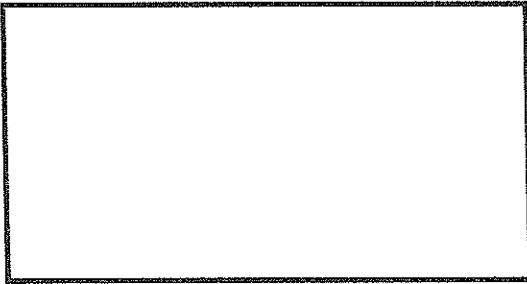
- Breakfast is free for all students all year!! 7:40-8:10a
